Application Deadline: 19 December 2024 (23:59:59 Eastern Time)

Video Submission Deadline: 19 December 2024 (23:59:59 Eastern Time) without late fee penalty

A late fee will be accessed after the deadline.

Absolute Video Submission Deadline: 21 December 2024 (23:59:59 Eastern Time) with late fee penalty

Judging Period: 24 December 2024 to 6th January 2025

Results will be published on our website on the 17th January 2025
